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1) New ADB Procurement Notice on Acid Rain Control and Environmental Improvement Project

Project Name: Acid Rain Control and Environmental Improvement Project

The People's Republic of China has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of the Acid Rain Control and Environmental Improvement Project and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to eligible payments under the contract for which this Invitation for Bids is issued.

2) New Regulation: Product Stewardship Policy for Domestic Appliances and Electronic Products

Based on the Solid Waste Pollution Prevention and Control Law and the Clean Production Promotion Law, the SEPA issued the Policy on Pollution Prevention Technology for Waste Domestic Appliances and Electronic Products on 14 August 2006, which came into force immediately.

In accordance with the "3Rs" (Reduce, Reuse and Recovery) and the "Polluter Pays" principles, the policy incorporates environmentally friendly design concepts, hazardous waste labeling, collection, transportation and storage, recycling and disposal of domestic appliances and electronic products.

3) Beijing: Management of Hazardous Chemicals

Based on the National Management Measures for Business Permits for Hazardous Chemicals, the Beijing Administration of Work Safety revised the Management Measures for Business Permits for Hazardous Chemicals on 8 September 2006, which came into effect on 1 October 2006. The old version has been abolished all companies relating to the production, wholesale, retail and distribution of hazardous chemicals within the administrative region of Beijing are affected by this Measure.

It covers requirements for the application and approval of business permits, process for changes to any permits, and their supervision and management.

4) Management Measures for Export Application and Approval for Hazardous Waste (under consultation)

Based on the Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and Their Disposal and the PRC's Solid Waste Pollution Prevention and Control Law, SEPA drafted the Management Measures for Export Application and Approval for Hazardous Waste (under consultation) on 10 July 2006.

The Measurement specifies the approval process for hazardous waste export applications, as well as the documents needed during the application procedure. It also outlines the management of Export Sheets for Hazardous Waste and the information reporting system for hazardous waste exports.

5) Liaoning Province: Ocean Environmental Protection Methods

Based on the PRC's Ocean Environmental Protection Law, Liaoning Province published the Ocean Environment Protection Methods on 4 July 2006, which came into affect on 1 August 2006.

The Methods apply to all activities related to navigation, exploration, extraction, production, tourism and scientific research, or onshore activities that impact the ocean environment. The methods provide requirements for: administrative institutes; monitoring and supervision; emergency planning; developing ocean resources; pollution control; environmental assessment; and, enforcement measures. It also includes the establishment of a Special Oceanic Protection Area.
