

- post office




Clackamas has bus service to Portland, which connects to light rail and the streetcar.




# Why is the Program for Intensive English the *SMART* choice?

# Class offerings are varied.


## ➤ Core classes

# High School Completion

➤ Students who don't have a high school diploma may earn one at Clackamas.

- Adult High School Diploma

- Students can earn college credit at the same time they are completing their high school degree.

# International Student Admissions

- Application
- Financial Statement
  - \$17,900 Official Bank Statement
- \$50 application fee
- Students are admitted to CCC.
  - No TOEFL Required



➤ **Health insurance is required for all international students.**

- from home country
- or
- purchase U.S. coverage



# Tuition for 2008-09



- Approximately \$2500, plus books
- Quarter system
  - 18 hours a week
  - 11 weeks for fall, winter, and spring terms
  - 8 weeks for summer term (\$1900)
