# Intensive English Program (IEP)

- Conditional Admission to UWM from for undergraduate study
- No TOEFL required for successful completion of IEP
- I-20 issued for full-time study
- 4 modules, in order of progression: Listening, Reading, Writing, Immersion
- Classroom time: 4 hours per day, 5 days per week
- Online placement testing
