- NEW EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS:** Submit five (5) photographs of the work you intend to sell. THESE WILL NOT BE RETURNED. They will be kept on file in the Rotary office to streamline the application process in the future. Photos should be close-ups of individual pieces or groupings. Photos must be no larger than 8 x 10, mounted on cardboard and encased in plastic. Your name must be clearly indicated on each page. Samples must be provided for edible products. A photograph or diagram of your proposed tent and booth display must be provided.

BOOTHS: **Please note: payment must be enclosed with this application.**
All cheques will be cashed. Cashing of cheque does not constitute acceptance into the show. If not accepted, we will refund the amount of your fee without interest.

Your booth must have adequate visible signage displaying either your name or trade name, so customers can easily identify you.

All booths are twelve (12) feet deep. Indicate your booth size preference from the selection below.

Exhibitor's Tent (INDOORS under a marquis) - Electrical Outlets are provided.

CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITING

Art in the Park is dedicated to maintaining the highest of standards. All applicants should understand and meet the following criteria.

1. All applications will be juried and all decisions are final.
2. Applicant must be the sole designer, creator and producer of the work being sold.
3. Mass-produced items not accepted.
4. Accepted applicants must be personally in attendance at the show, on at least a part time basis, and provide all personnel for their own booth.
5. Exhibitors must display and sell only the type of work or items approved by the jury.

APPLICATION

1. **Application deadline is March 31, 2009.** Applicants will be notified of acceptance by April 30, 2009.
2. Late applications will be received, but acceptance will be based on jury results and availability of space.
3. Payment must be included with application. No post-dated cheques, please.
